ERA-8224	User is informed if there are unresolved divergences after project activation	<p>As a modeler, I would like to be informed if there are some unresolved divergences in the DMS schema, in order to be able to correct them manually.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Designer informs the user that schema was deployed but that there exist unresolved divergences after project activation</li></ul>
TUK-8	The inbox list can be filtered using more than one search term for the search field	<p>As a user, I want to be able to filter the inbox list by more than one term combined with AND so that I can find these easily in a long list of tasks.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If more than one term is entered into the filter of the inbox task list the search is working locally and show only tasks containing all the terms either in the title or the subject of the task list.</li></ul>
TUK-40	The full-text search can be restricted to content or index (2 Sprints)	<p>As a user, I would like to be able to specify for the full-text search whether the search should only be carried out in the metadata or in the files or in both, so that the number of hits can be suitably limited.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the search dialogue, the buttons 'All' / 'Alles', 'Document files only' / 'Nur Dokumentdateien', and 'Metadata only' / 'Nur Metadaten' are controlling the search. Default is all. The setting is remembered in the same way as it is for all other search parameters.</li><li>• Saved searches are supported as well</li></ul>
TUK-489	The passwords can be held encrypted in the service configuration files	<p>As an administrator, I want that all passwords including database and Elasticsearch passwords can be held encrypted in the configuration files.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The passwords in the configuration files can be encrypted or not.</li><li>• During the installation, the passwords for the database are encrypted.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• During the system update, the database password is not touched.
