COOL-9314	yuvis RAD search-service	You can control the relevance of hits by configuration	<p>As a user, I want context folders to be listed first in the case of a full text search, because I would rather have found them than the objects in them.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is possible to configure preferred fields that are more relevant.• After a full-text search, the context folders found are first listed in the hit list.• It is possible to configure which fields influence the relevance under which conditions, e.g.• There is a catalog field and a certain order of the catalog values should be considered.
COOL-11793	yuvis RAD core-service	The retrieval of renditions is more performant	<p>As a user of the webclient I want renditions to be displayed as fast as possible. The current way a rendition for an object is retrieved is the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. rest request over dms-sidecar to dms-service2. dms-service loads content file from storage3. dms-service streams content file over dms-sidecar and rendition-sidecar to rendition-plus4. rendition-plus calculates digest5. rendition-plus loads rendition for calculated digest from cache or created new one on cache-miss6. rendition-plus streams rendition over rendition-sidecar and dms-sidecar to dms-service7. dms-service responds to initial rest request with rendition as body <p>Since it is possible to request a rendition for an object directly from rendition-plus by its objectid, this can be optimized a lot by using the following way:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. rest request over rendition-sidecar to rendition-plus using the URL http://<rendition>/osrenditioncache/app/api/document/<objekt-ID>/rendition/pdf?timeout=600002. rendition-plus loads requested rendition from cache ([a]) or generates error on cache-miss ([b])3. [a]: rendition-plus responds over rendition-sidecar to initial request with the rendition as body [b]: request creation of new rendition (using the above way)
COOL-12310	yuvis RAD client	You can set a filter on an ID-reference field via scripting	<p>As an administrator, I want be able to reduce the list of found objects within the selection dialog for an ID-reference field, to support users only selecting allowed objects.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is possible to set a filter for an ID-reference field similar to the setFilter function for an user /group field as given, e.g.: <pre>scope.model.responsibles.setQueryFilters({ "personalakte.name": { o: 'eq', v1: 'Engel' } })</pre> <p>Alternative: formulate the search string part as formulate for a call via Search API.</p>
COOL-13295	yuvis RAD core-service	The content file deduplication feature is performance-optimized	<p>As an administrator, I want the system staying performant that contains many content files (several million).</p> <p>Current situation: the query of the deduplication feature for the sysdigest in the xdpsnodeelem table is a bottleneck.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• An index on the sysdigest field of the xdpsnodeelem table is created per default (for existing systems via update class)

COOL-13435	yuavis RAD agent, yuavis RAD client	You can set the email addresses using a custom action for sending an email	<p>As a programmer, I want be able to set the e-mail addresses using a custom action for sending an email if these are known and the user gets his effort reduced.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is possible to set these addresses (to,cc,bcc) in a custom action script • The agent transfers these addresses into the email
COOL-13580	yuavis RAD client, yuavis RAD core-service	You can control whether a content duplicate check should be performed	<p>As an administrator, I will be able to disable the duplicate check if the performance of the system is too much affected.</p> <p>Problem: In specific cases (many object types accessed by the user), the time for checking takes some seconds instead of milliseconds.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A capability 'Enable check content duplicate' can be set in the management studio under system/core service/ global/server. 2. The check is optimized using a DB index.
COOL-13695	yuavis RAD client	On the dashboard, you can open the result list for an aggregation element via keyboard control	<p>As a user, I want to navigate via keyboard controls through the aggregations so that I don't have to touch the mouse.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • it is possible to focus the aggregation's components via keyboard access.
COOL-13696	yuavis RAD client	You can add all found references with a click	<p>As a user, I want to be able to add all found reference with a single click so that I can reduce the effort to adding more than one.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In the selection dialog for references, an 'Select all' is offered. A click on it checks all elements of the search.
COOL-13697	yuavis RAD client	You can disable catalog entries via scripting	<p>As a client scripeter, I want to disable and enable the catalog entries if specific business logic requests this.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A filter function disables the catalog entry.
COOL-13834	yuavis RAD agent	You can discard all documents with one click	<p>As a user, I want to be able to discard all my documents that are being edited at once, so that I don't have to cumbersomely throw each one.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is a button 'Discard all documents ...' in the dialog at the appropriate place.
ERA-2079	yuavis RAD core-service	Syntax of clauses is validated prior to schema and roleset activation	<p>As a modeler, I would like to verify the technical correctness of clauses defined in roles prior to their activation, in order to prevent the issue where a clause containing syntax errors can prevent rights system from activating and lead to subsequent errors in yuavis RAD server.</p> <p>Acceptance criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clauses are validated during schema validation/activation • The validation checks only the syntax of clauses, not semantics. I.e., the validation does not check whether objecttypes or fields referenced in clauses exist, but check whether the clause syntax results in a valid database queries • Rights/Clauses that are syntactically incorrect are shown as errors in the validation window
